Peter came-to Jesus, asked, “Lord, happen my brother wrong against me.

How-many times must forgive? 7 times?”

Jesus answer, “No, not 7 times. 70 X 7 times. Tell you story, will . . .

Reign of God compare king, himself decide: Servants owe money, collect will. King called servant, owe lot money: can’t pay. King order sell man, wife, children, land . . . pay for debt. Servant kneel before-him, say: ‘My lord, patience with me: pay full will.’ King touched pity, full debt excused.

Servant left, met servant (equal), owe small amount money. Grab man, threaten, demand, 'Money you owe-me, pay!' Servant kneel, beg, 'Need more time, pay full will.' First servant refuse pay-attention. Order man put-in-jail until pay full.

Other servants see things finish happen, scared. Go-to King, tell story recent happen. King call servant, say 'You terrible! You beg me, I cancel full debt. You should do same for other servant, right?!?'

King angry: order servant punish, torture until pay full owe."

Story finish, mean what? Jesus explain: "My Father heaven act same with you, happen you refuse forgive."
