Reading from gospel writer Mark

(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, lips, heart, hands)

Jesus led Peter, James, John up high mountain. Arrive there, in presence apostles, happen Jesus his appearance change — clothes white bright, more white than possible from bleach. Appear with Jesus — Elijah, Moses, two-them talk with Jesus. Peter said, "Rabbi, good for us be here. We set-up three tents will, 1-for you, 1-for Moses, 1-for Elijah. Peter speak, understand self not, because three apostles shocked. Cloud appear, cover all them, voice God say, "this my Son, cherish. Pay-attention him." Immediately three apostles look-around, see only Jesus, others gone.

While walk down mountain, Jesus order strict: tell no one things recently see, wait until Son of Man rise from dead. Apostles tell no one, but discuss amount themselves meaning — “rise from dead.”
