(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, +lips, +heart, +hands)

Jesus tell story: Kingdom God compare with situation, wedding. Time, evening, 10 bridesmaids, with torches (lamps) ready meet bridegroom; wait-for him show-up. 5 bridesmaids foolish: have lamps, not enough oil continue burn. 5 bridesmaids wise: have lamps, bring oil in jar, happen oil use-up, have more for use. Bridegroom very late. Bridesmaids fall-asleep.

Time, midnight. Person announce, "Bridegroom arrive soon. Come, meet him." Bridesmaids wake-up; prepare lamps. Foolish girls say, "Our oil used-up. Some your oil, give-us." wise girls say, "No! Happen, our oil give-you, not enough for us. Go-to people sell oil, buy for yourselves." Foolish girls left.

While gone, bridegroom arrive. 5 wise girls ready, enter room for wedding celebration. Door closed, locked.

Later 5 foolish girls arrive, knock, say, "Open door, let us in." Bridegroom say, "I tell you honest. Don't-know you."

Lesson: Be ready always. Son of Man appear will: buy you don't know time or place.
