Reading from gospel writer Matthew

(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, +lips, +heart, +hands)

Jesus told His disciples: You serve two masters, impossible. Will hate one and love other; or pay-attention one, forget other. Serve, give life to God and money some time, can't.

I warn you: things need for life – eat, drink, clothes, don't worry. Life more important than food; body more important than clothes.

Look-at birds, they don't plant seed or harvest. But Father in heaven feeds them. You more important than birds? yes! Suppose you worry; can that add time your life? For clothes, why worry? Learn lesson from wild flowers – do they work, make clothes, no. But truly, anything more beautiful than flowers, no. Because God can make flowers grow beautiful, live short time then die. You more important than flowers; your needs satisfy better. Your faith weak. Don't worry about things like – eat what? drink what? wear what? People who don't believe want those things. Your Father in heaven knows all your needs. Instead, want God's kingdom and life in you, then all other things you need, will receive. Don't worry about future. Willing future take-care itself. Now have enough worries pay-attention.
