Deuteronomy 5: 12-15

Reading from book name Deuteronomy

Remember must keep Sabbath day holy, same Lord God commanded. Work - work - work six days fine, but 7th day true Sabbath, holy day for rest, focus on God. That day no person should work — not you, son, daughter, slaves — nothing.... even animals should not work. All should rest same.

Remember, long ago, yourselves slaves in Egypt. Lord God saved you, led you out with His strength. That's why Lord God commands all must obey Sabbath holy day.

Sign with joy to God our helper.

Make music noise on full moon night. That solemn (serious) celebration-feast.

Reading from book name Second Corinthians

We don't preach about ourselves; we preach about the Lord. We are your servants for Jesus. God said, "Let light shine from darkness." Now he shines in our hearts, so we can proclaim the glory of God show thru Christ.

We have this gift now in our bodies - shows power comes from God, not from us.

We suffer in many ways, but we are not depressed. We doubt, but never stop believing. We are mocked, but never alone. We fal, but never destroyed.
