**First Reading:**

**Acts 10:34a, 37-43**

### **Reading from book name Acts**

Peter began speak; “You know happen all over Judea, begin in town Galilee. First happen baptism John preach. What? God anoint Jesus from Nazareth with Holy Spirit and power. Do you know that a little yeast leavens (raises) all dough?

Because our pascal (Passover) lamb, Christ himself, was sacrificed.

Therefore, we celebrate the feast, not with old yeast.

Old yeast same as act mean and wicked.

But we celebrate with unleavened bread,  
same as act with sincerity and truth.
