Reading from gospel writer Mark

(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, +lips, +heart, +hands)

Jesus and followers traveled many different, different towns. While walk, Jesus ask followers: “People say, me who?” Followers answer, “Some say — John Baptizer, other people say — yourself Elijah, other people say you are prophet.”

Jesus asked, “You...say?, me who?”

Peter answer, “You Christ, Savior...Messiah!”

Jesus order followers, “Tell no one about me.”

Jesus teach followers himself suffer must. Explain, explain: “Older Jewish leaders, priests, teachers of law reject me will. Must die. Three-days-later rise.” Jesus spoke clear.

Peter led Jesus aside, tell him, “No! Not happen to you!” Jesus look-around-at-followers, then Peter. Jesus scold Peter: “You, Satan, get out! Judge how?.....follow people, not God.”

Jesus call crowd and followers, say, “Suppose you want follow me, how? Must say ‘No’ to things you want. Must accept cross, suffering, follow me. Person wants-to save his life must lose it. Every person gives his life for Me and for Good News, that person save his life forever will.”
