Jesus told this story to His follower: “A man was going on a trip. The man called his servants and gave his money to them, thinking about each person’s skills. To one person the man gave five thousand coins; to a second person two thousand; and to a third person one thousand. Then the man went away.

The person who received five thousand went to invest the money; he earned five thousand more. Also the person who received two thousand earned two thousand more. But the person who received one thousand went and dug a hole and hid the money.

After a long time the master came home and tried to finish his business with his servants. The person who received five thousand came, bringing

with him another five thousand. He said, “My lord, you let me have five thousand. See, I earned five thousand more.”

His master said, “You did right. You are a good servant, you did right with small things; now I will let you take-care-of larger things. Come share my joy!”

Then the person who received two thousand came. He said, “My lord, you trusted me with two thousand, and I earned two thousand more.”

The master said, “You are a clever and good servant. You did right with small things; Now I will let you take-care-of later things. Come, share my joy!”

Last, the man who received one thousand came and said, “My lord, I know you are very hard man. You harvest things where you yourself did not plant before. I was afraid. I hid your thousand coins in the ground Here is your money.”

The master shouted, “You worthless, lazy servant! You know I harvest things where I did not plant. That’s why you should put my money in the bank. When I returned I could get my money plus interest.

You, there - talk the thousand away and give it to the servant who has ten thousand. People who have much will receive more and become rich. But people who have little will lose, everything. Throw this worthless servant outside in the darkness. There he will cry-out with pain.”
