Reading from the first book of Samuel

Reading from gospel writer John

(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, lips, heart, hands)

While Jesus walked, saw man blind since birth. Jesus pick-up-dirt, spit-on-it, made mud, put on man his eyes. Jesus told him, "Go to pool name Siloam, wash." Man left, arrive pool, wash, then came back, now see can. Neighbors and other people, in-past see blind man beg, asked, "thank man, same before, sit, beg?" Some people say yes, others say man different but look like him. Man said, "Yes, that's me."

Some people led man, before blind, to Pharisees. (Notice, Jesus made mud, gave man sight on Sabbath, against law.) Pharisees asked man how possible now see.
