John 2:13-25

Praise you Lord Jesus Christ, King glory forever

The Lord be with you (response) SAME YOUR SPIRIT Reading from gospel writer Mark (response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, lips, heart, hands)

Time Jewish Passover approach, Jesus go-to Jerusalem. Jesus enter temple area, see people sell oxen, sheep, birds; other people money changers. Jesus make whip, chase-out sellers, money changers their tables knock-over, coins spill all-over. Tell people selling birds, "Get out!" My Father his house not store. Finish!!" Jesus his disciples remember Scripture, "God your house want go, enthusiastic."

Jews question Jesus, "What authority you have do this, prove?" Jesus answer, "This temple destroy, 3 days later rise again will." Jews mock Jesus, "This temple build require 46 years; build again 3 days impossible!" Jesus mean temple itself no, mean own body. Later, Jesus finish rise from dead, disciples recall things Jesus say; at later time believe Jesus and Scripture.

While Jesus in Jerusalem for Passover, many people believe him, why? see actions. Jesus trust people fully, no, because understand human nature, secrets in people hearts.
